**Minutes**

1. The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairperson Reinhart at 9:00 a.m. in Room C129 of the Marinette County Courthouse.

Motion (Lacourciere/Sauld) to approve the agenda. Motion carried. No negative votes.

3. MINUTES

Motion (Holley/Pott) to approve the minutes of the January 8<sup>th</sup> 2016 meeting. Motion carried. No negative votes.

6. TIPPING FEE CONTAMINATED SOIL VILLAGE OF WAUSAUKEE DOT PROJECT

Lefebvre informed the Committee that he had been asked by a contractor what the charge would be for hauling in contaminated soil from the WI DOT project in the Village of Wausaukee.

Motion (Holley/Lacourciere) to set the tipping fee at \$15 per ton for any contaminated soil that originates from the Village of Wausaukee, DOT project that is suitable for use as daily cover. Motion carried. No negative votes.

7. LANDFILL COMPACTOR PIN-ON TEETH

Lefebvre informed the Committee that recently he observed that the pin-on teeth on the wheels of the landfill compactor are within their last 10% of life and that at least one is worn through to the base that holds the teeth on the wheel drum. The price for a new set of wheels would be \$90,000 plus the labor and crane costs to install the wheels. The cost associated with replacing the pin-on teeth is \$49,969 plus labor. Labor is anticipated to be \$65 per hour and the project is estimated to take 150 man hours. A portable air compressor will need to be rented at a cost of \$450 per week and some other minor supplies will be needed to complete the project. The Pin-On Teeth for the Caron wheels are only produced by Caron Company and therefore obtaining a quote from another vendor was not possible.

Motion (Sauld/Lacourciere) to authorize the purchase of the pin-on teeth from Caron Company for \$49,969 which includes delivery and the rental of a puller kit for removal and installation of the new pin-on teeth and to utilize labor from Richlen Excavating to provide install the pin-on teeth at a cost of \$65 per hour per man hour. Motion carried. No negative votes.

8. GROUNDWATER ASSESSMENT MONITORING

Lefebvre informed the Committee that he had contacted a geologist by the name of Paula Leier – Engelhardt, who has done some work for Mar-Oco in the past, to evaluate what it would take to convince the WDNR to allow Mar-Oco to return to a normal protocol for monitoring of the groundwater wells. Mar-Oco has completed its 8 rounds of assessment monitoring and is now in a

position to petition the WDNR to modify this assessment monitoring. Lefebvre will report back to the committee when he has more information regarding the matter.

9. LANDFILL OPERATIONS

Lefebvre reported that the pump in the leachate tank went out last Thursday. On Monday a loaner pump was installed by Xylem Water Solutions to allow for the loading of the trucks why the pump is being fixed. The quoted price to fix the pump is \$2,000 however that cost does not include the cost of diagnosing the problem and installing the temporary pump and then re-installing the pump once it is fixed. The landfill compactor and loader are both running well. A window in the loader broke and needed to be replaced. In the first week of February waste began to be placed in the bottom of Increment A Phase III. Leachate lines in Increment A Phase III were cleaned and televised. Upon WDNR review and approval of the results of the televising the waste will then be allowed to be placed over the leachate lines and until that approval is received the waste is being kept 5 feet from the leachate lines.


The January and February 2016 schedule of paid invoices (\$77,741.01) was distributed for Committee review.
