

CAMPING

When you arrive at Chute Pond to camp, please register at the Field House. Check in time is 3:00 p.m. There are 74 camp sites for tents or trailers for daily rental. Sites 84-100 are ATV-UTV sites. We also have a group site available.

DAILY RATES \$25.00

The rate includes two adults and their children under 18 or four adults per site. Please register at Field House before setting up.

Refund Policy: Camping voucher will be issued, to be used within existing camping season. No refund voucher two weeks before camping date.

Help us keep our cost down. Please recycle and keep garbage to minimum, if you can carry in – carry out.


USER LAUNCH FEES

About Chute Pond

The 147-acre Chute Pond Park was established as an Oconto County Park and picnic area in 1935.

The original Chute Pond Dam was built about 1853 to store water for the logging drives down the Oconto River. In 1935 the old wooden chute dam was replaced. The park has available for campers drinking water, flush and pit toilets, showers, firewood, picnic tables, swimming, hiking trails, fishing, and boat launch.
