### All Terrain Vehicle Operation in Wisconsin


**NEW!** All operators at least age 12 and born on or after Jan. 1, 1988 must complete an ATV Safety Certification course in order to operate on public ATV trails and areas in Wisconsin. Operators of all terrain vehicles (ATV) now have a convenient online method to receive ATV Safety Certification through an Internet Web course recently introduced by the state Department of Natural Resources. The Internet course is available at [www.offroad-ed.com/wi](http://www.offroad-ed.com/wi). - ATV TRAILS OPEN MAY 1 TO OCTOBER 31
- CARRY IN / CARRY OUT
- NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES BEYOND GATES
- PRIMITIVE CAMPING BY PERMIT
- 10 MPH SPEED LIMIT WHEN WITHIN 100 FT OF NON-MOTORIZED USERS OR DWELLINGS
- CITATION FORFEITURES UP TO \$501.00 FOR MOST ATV VIOLATIONS




