# LANDFILL OPERATIONS

(April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018)

- Batteries**
- must be separated (NiCad, alkaline, ion) into separate containers
  - must be taped to prevent contact with each other or any conductor
  - fee associated with disposal.
- WDNR Quarterly Inspection**
- March 29<sup>th</sup> inspection found Mar-Oco Landfill to be in compliance.
- Contaminated Soil**
- the TCLP tests for the contaminated soil from the Beaver, WI site came back and are well within the acceptance limits of the Mar-Oco Special Waste Acceptance Criteria for use as daily cover.
- Long Term Care**
- we are in the process of investigating different financial institutions with higher rates of return with the thought of shifting some of the long term care funds.
- Gas Well – 4**
- leachate was bailed from gas well 4 to lower the liquid level.
- Financial Audit**
- Mar-Oco Landfill had its financial audit on March 27<sup>th</sup>. Results are fourth coming.
